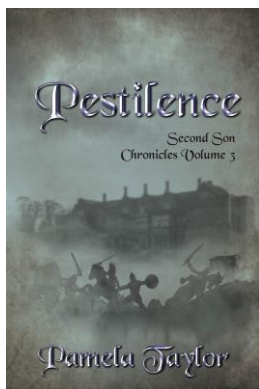

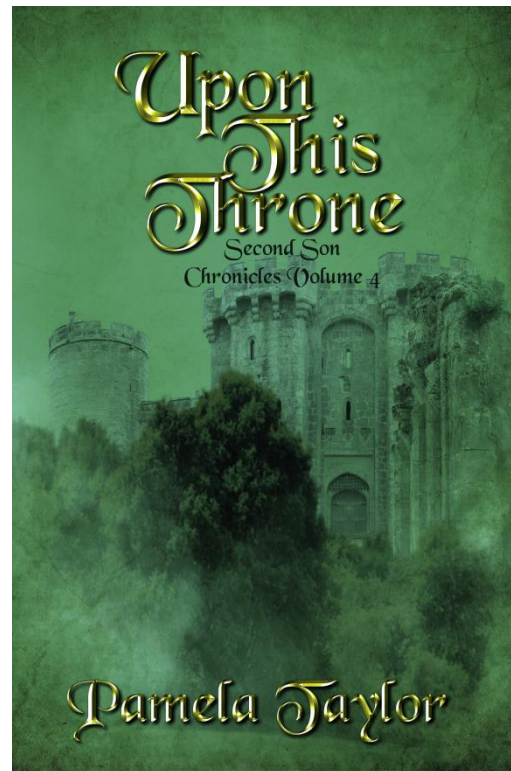
the cover. And it's now also available in a hard cover edition at Amazon.
